

PHOTO BINGO SCAVENGER HUNT INSTRUCTIONS

We will have a Photo Bingo Scavenger Hunt as a starting activity for our Photography unit.

A few details:

- To win in Bingo, you need to create a line of five consecutive squares in the horizontal, vertical or diagonal directions.
- In order to consider a square “completed”, you need to **take a photo** of the item described in the square.
- To be confirmed the winner, you need to share this document with your teacher with your photos inside the squares instead of the text.



Rules:

- You must take the photo.
- You cannot take a photo of another photo or digital image that contains your object.
- Each object must be in a separate photo.
- The quality of the photo needs to be reasonable.

Example of a Bingo card:

Surprise your pet and take a photo
...	An avocado sliced in two
...	...	Free
...	Shoes at the door	...
...	A toothpaste tube beside a sink.
