2020 MEDAL DESIGN CONTEST SCOPE

ELIGIBILITY: Students from affiliated high schools and colleges are eligible to participate. If your school is not affiliated, please contact info@skillsontario.com

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by email competitions@skillsontario.com or post-marked no later than **Friday November 8, 2019**

MEDAL DESIGN SPECIFICATIONS:

- Designs may be created by hand or on computer. Designs must be submitted in black and white on 8 ½" x 11" paper. The design must be shown in **actual size**, the maximum size being 3" x 3."
- Medal is two-sided. Both the front and the back design of the medal must be shown. No colours will be added; only the colour of the medal material will be used (bronze, silver, gold).
- The design **MUST** incorporate: 1) the year of the competition (2020); and 2) the words "Skills Ontario Competition". The competition is no longer called OTSC and this should not appear in your design.

CONTEST RULES:

- Only **ONE** medal design per student can be submitted for consideration. Students are encouraged to enter both the pin and medal design contests. Please use a separate page for the medal design entry and the pin design entry.
- All design entries **must** include the student's name, school name & school board, teacher/advisor's name, applicable course, grade/year, complete home mailing address and home phone number.
- Electronic files will only be accepted in **PDF** or **EPS** formats. File name should include the student's first/last name and contest (e.g. Anna_Smith_Medal_Contest.pdf).
- All submissions become the property of Skills Ontario and will not be returned. Skills Ontario has the right to reproduce the design, or modify it, in any media and in whatever quantity we choose. Winners may be contacted to provide a working file of their design.
- The winning designs or facsimiles thereof will be reproduced as the official medal of the 2020 Skills Ontario Competition and may also be displayed during the dates of the competition: May 4-6, 2020 at the Toronto Congress Centre.
- Please note: Skills Ontario is a not-for-profit organization and not a government office. Although trillium and maple leaf designs may be used, they are neither expected nor required.
- This is an individual event. No teams please!

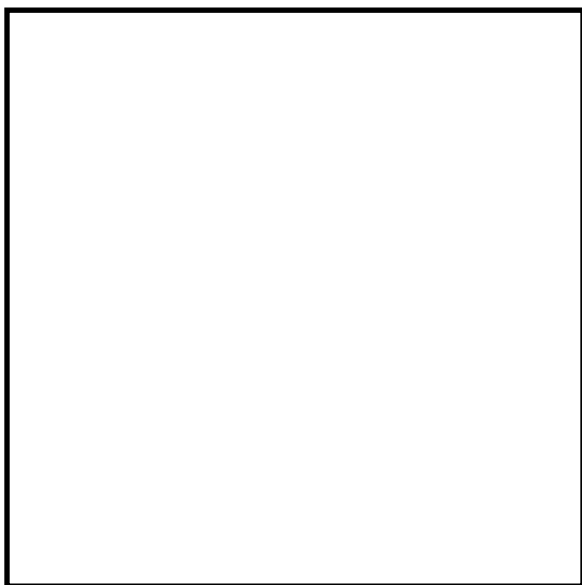

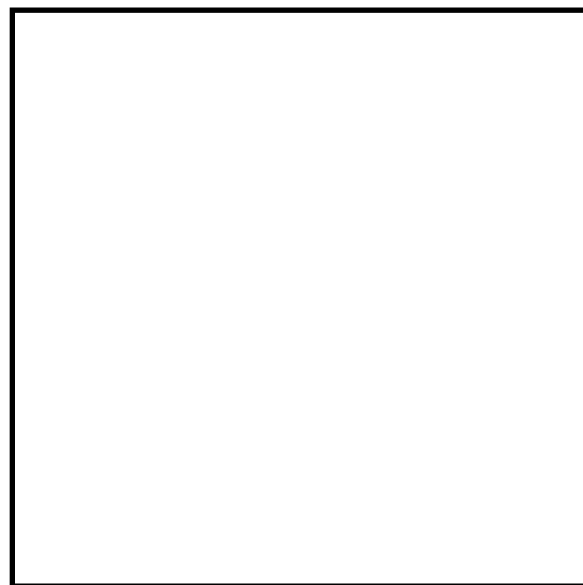
