2022 PIN DESIGN CONTEST SCOPE

ELIGIBILITY: Students from affiliated high schools and colleges are eligible to participate. If your school is not affiliated, visit our website at www.skillsontario.com.

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by email or post-marked no later than **Friday November 12, 2021**

PIN DESIGN SPECIFICATIONS:

- Designs may be created by hand or on computer. Designs must be submitted in full colour on 8½" x 11" paper and include a 1" x 1" scaled copy of the design. This assists in determining if the design can be easily reduced to a 1" x 1" sized pin.
- The design may have a maximum of 3 colours. Black and white are considered colours. The metal pin material is not considered one of the three colours, but will appear at the edge of your design.
- Designs <u>MUST</u> incorporate: 1) the year of the competition (2022); and 2) the words "Skills Ontario Competition" or S.O.C. and "Olympiades de Compétences Ontario" or O.C.O. Acronyms are acceptable substitutes for spelling out the entire name of the event in both English and French. The competition is no longer called OTSC and this should <u>not</u> appear in your design.
- All designs must be bilingual.

CONTEST RULES:

- Only <u>ONE</u> pin design per student can be submitted for consideration. Students are encouraged to
 enter both the pin and medal design contests. Please use a separate page for the pin design entry
 and medal design entry.
- All design entries <u>must</u> include the student's name, school name & school board, teacher/advisor's name, applicable course, grade/year, complete home mailing address and home phone number.
- Electronic files will only be accepted in <u>PDF</u> or <u>EPS</u> formats. File name should include the student's first/last name and contest (e.g. Anna_Smith_Pin_Contest.pdf).
- All submissions become the property of Skills Ontario and will not be returned. Skills Ontario has the right to reproduce the design, or modify it, in any media and in whatever quantity we choose.
 Winners may be contacted to provide a working file of their design.
- The winning designs or facsimiles thereof will be reproduced as the official pin of the 2022 Skills Ontario Competition and may also be displayed during the dates of the competition.
- Please note: Skills Ontario is a not-for-profit organization and not a government office. Although trillium and maple leaf designs may be used, they are neither expected nor required.
- This is an individual event. No teams please!
